*CHiPs* aired on NBC from September 15, 1977, to May 1, 1983. The show follows the lives of two motorcycle officers of the California Highway Patrol (CHP).

Much of the filming for the first two seasons was done on the *yet-to-be-completed* 2 and 210 Freeways.

Local filmmaker, **John Newcombe** has compiled many of the "**CHiPs**" scenes filmed in our area, as well as other TV shows like **Emergency!** and **Adam 12** and some movies too — all of which took advantage of the unopened freeways. This is a fun and entertaining blast from the past which at times feels more like watching home movies from the late 1970s!
